Doctors often recommend receiving the flu vaccination in October as flu activity in our area usually begins in October. The State of New Jersey mandates that all children 6-59 months receive a flu vaccine by December 31st. Please submit documentation of your child's

vaccination; students without flu vaccine documentation are not allowed back after winter break until documentation is received.

Colds and COVID

Westminster's 2023-2024 COVID Policy was emailed out this week. If you would like a hard copy, please let the office know and a copy will be put in your child's backpack. A friendly reminder - the common cold and COVID share symptoms. If your child is experiencing any symptoms such as cough, fever, sore throat, vomiting or diarrhea, you may consider obtaining a COVID test.

Although we've been experiencing a return of warm temperatures, we know colder weather is on its way. The clothes you brought in September for your child to change into (if needed) may not be warm enough now! Please bring in pants and long-sleeved shirts to replace those t-shirts and shorts.
